MARY ELEANOR BUSCHEK TRAVEL AWARD

for Foreign Language Study

Approximately \$2000 per year may be distributed **to Languages, Cultures, and International Trade graduate and undergraduate majors** for study abroad. Students should aim for a study abroad program which is supported by SIUC or approved through the Department of Language, Cultures, and International Trade. Students may receive a maximum of two awards.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- The student must attend SIUC in the Fall and Spring of the award year unless graduation occurs mid-year. (Study Abroad programs which are pre-approved by the Languages, Cultures, and International Trade advisor will be considered as fulfillment of this criteria.)
- The student must declare and maintain as his/her primary (first) major any majors offered by the Department of Languages, Cultures, and International Trade within the College of Liberal Arts.
- The student must maintain full-time enrollment (at least 12 hours Undergraduate-level or at least 6 Graduate hours) per Fall and Spring semesters unless graduation occurs mid-year.
- The student must have an overall GPA of 3.0 and a major GPA of 3.25 or better.

<u>Procedure:</u> Students may nominate themselves or faculty may nominate students. Nominees must submit a completed application form and attach a current SIUC unofficial transcript. A faculty member must submit the recommendation form on your behalf. The departmental awards committee will select award recipient(s). The award will be credited to the recipient's bursar account at the beginning of the semester prior to the planned travel. The student will be acknowledged at and be expected to attend University Honor's Day in April.

Application materials must arrive in the office of the Department of Languages, Cultures, and International Trade in Faner 2166 by the <u>January 31, 2018 deadline</u>. No late applications will be accepted.
