INTERCULTURAL COMMUNICATION: A PEACE BUILDING PERSPECTIVE [SPECIAL TOPICS COURSE]

Therefore, it is even more essential to pursue peace when differences are being politicized to create chasms and wars rather than mutual understanding and respect. This special topics course will focus on how the ways in which we communicate and represent can help build peaceful communities and communication across cultural and ideological differences.
