



## PREPARING FOR ADVISEMENT

1. **Check in with the main College of Liberal Arts (CoLA) advisement office.**
  - a. Located in **Faner Hall**. Enter Door 6 at the mid-way point in Faner. Take the stairs or elevator to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Follow the signs that read **CoLA Advisement**.

2. **Get familiar with [Degree Works](#).**
  - a. If you can search for University Core Curriculum (UCC) options ahead of time, this will help make sure you have a voice in choosing your classes!

3. When in Salukinet, follow this path to browse for class options.

- Open [SALUKINET](#)
- Select **REGISTER FOR CLASSES**
- Select **BROWSE FOR CLASSES**
- Choose the appropriate **TERM**
- Select **ADVANCED SEARCH**
- At the bottom, click in the **ATTRIBUTE** box to search for specific courses guaranteed to fulfill your UCC requirements
- If registration is already open, it may help to also select **OPEN SECTIONS ONLY**

## INTERPRETING CLASS SELECTIONS

- Most classes meet 3 days a week for 50-minute sessions or 2 days a week for an hour and 15-minute sessions.
