

ENGLISH 599 (THESIS) REQUEST

An MA thesis shall be supervised by a committee of at least three members of the graduate faculty and may be counted for not more than six nor less than three semester hours of credit, with no more than three credit hours in a given semester.

Students who have completed all course work and have registered for the minimum number of thesis or research hours required for the degree are subject to the Graduate School's continuing enrollment (English 601) requirement. Students are responsible for ascertaining the relevant Graduate School deadline for the semester in which they wish to graduate. For all deadlines, see Graduation Deadlines for Graduate Students, regularly posted in the Department. Other essential information, including the proper format for the thesis, may be found in *Guidelines for the Preparation of Dissertations, Theses, and Research Papers*, available in the Graduate Studies office and online.

The Graduate School requires that all students make an appointment to have a consultant review their dissertation prior to making the final copy.
