SCORE SHEET: DRAMATIC INTERPRETATION (Recitation and interpretation of a memorized prose or poetic passage.) Students should have memorized their selection and provided each judge with a copy of the memorized text.

Participants are judged on the following categories:

1. **Pronunciation**

2. Fluency 3. Memorization 4. Poise/Interpretation

5. Difficulty/Length of text.

There is a 5 -minute time limit and students who exceed the limit may be stopped without penalty to their score.

Students will receive a numerical score for each of the categories according to the following scale:

10-9: *S*(*uperior*);

8-7: *E*(*xcellent*)

6-5: *G*(*ood*)

4-3: *A*(*verage*);

2-1: F(air).

Scores will then be tallied for a final evaluation and numerical grade. The "Total" column will be averaged with the other judge's results to provide a final average. Students will then be assigned a letter grade (S/E/G/A/F) in the "Rating" column.

50-45= S(uperior)

44-38= E(xcellent) **37-31**=G(ood)

30-24=**A**(*verage*)

below 24=F(air)
