

CHECKLIST FOR POLITICAL SCIENCE MAJORS WITH A PRE-LAW SPECIALIZATION

The undergraduate catalog lists all of the requirements for a Political Science major with a Pre-Law specialization. This checklist may be used to plan and keep track of your progress toward these requirements.

Meet these general requirements:

- University core curriculum requirements (41 credit hours)
- College of Liberal Arts requirements (11 credit hours)
- Minor (12-18 credit hours)
- Electives (17-20 credit hours)

Take these five courses that are required of all political science majors:

- POLS 205 Introduction to Political Thought
- POLS 250 Introduction to Comparative Politics
- POLS 270 Introduction to International Relations
- POLS 300 Research Methods

Take these three courses:

- POLS 230 Law in American Society
- POLS 333A Constitutional Law I
- POLS 333B Constitutional Law II

Pick two of the following courses:

- POLS 435 Judicial Process and Behavior
- POLS 436 Administrative Law
- POLS 437 Jurisprudence (Theories of Law).
- POLS 438 Women and the Law
- POLS 475 International Law

Pick one 400-level elective:

- POLS 4xx

Pick two POLS 300-level or 400-level electives:

- POLS elective 1
- POLS elective 2
