

CHECKLIST FOR POLITICAL SCIENCE MAJORS WITH A PUBLIC SERVICE SPECIALIZATION

The undergraduate catalog lists all of the requirements for a Political Science major with a Public Service specialization. This checklist may be used to plan and keep track of your progress toward these requirements.

Meet these general requirements:

- University core curriculum requirements (41 credit hours)
- College of Liberal Arts requirements (11 credit hours)
- Minor (12-18 credit hours)
- Electives (17-20 credit hours)

Take these five courses that are required of all political science majors:

- POLS 114 Introduction to American Politics (also a University Core Curriculum course)
- POLS 205 Introduction to Political Thought
- POLS 250 Introduction to Comparative Politics
- POLS 270 Introduction to International Relations
- POLS 300 Research Methods

Important Notes:

1. Students must take **POLS 340 Intro to PA** either as a prerequisite or concurrently with another course in the specialization.

2. In addition to POLS 340, students must take three of the following courses:

- POLS 422 NPO's and NGO's: Doing Good Better
- POLS 432 Grant Writing
- POLS 436 Administrative Law
- POLS 442 Human Resources Admin
- POLS 443 Fiscal Aspects of PA
- POLS 444 Policy Analysis
- POLS 447 Nonprofit Marketing and Fundraising
- POLS 449 Management of Nonprofit ORG's
