Note: Many of our graduates receive their degrees in 5.5 years, with their degrees posting in December, because their internship ended or dissertation defense occurred too late in the summer to make the university's deadline for August graduation. Those students are counted as having completed in 5 years.

Our program is designed to take students from the Bachelor's degree to the Ph.D. We do accept students with prior graduate work, and we may waive some course requirements for courses taken elsewhere. However, those graduate credits taken elsewhere do not count toward required credit hours for the doctoral degree granted from SIU. Students may substitute elective coursework for comparable courses taken elsewhere.
