CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Small Grant Awards

The SIUC Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies Program is pleased to announce its Small Grant Awards for this spring 2020 semester. The purpose of the grant is to provide financial support to undergraduate and graduate students and junior faculty for projects that will result in community contributions, professional networking, skill building, public creative works, academic travel, and pilot studies. The program will award grants of between \$200 to \$500. Grant amount may increase in the case of few applicants. Deadline is March 8, 2020. For requirements and on how to apply, see below.

REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate

Must be enrolled at SIUC and minoring in WGSS. Newly enrolled students can apply.

Graduate

Must be a current SIUC graduate student and enrolled in the WGSS Graduate Certificate Program. Newly enrolled students can apply.

Junior Faculty

HOW TO APPLY

SEND THE FOLLOWING

1. A one-page CV with name, degree, dept. of study, and WGSS minor or graduate certificate date of enrollment. (Junior faculty can ignore this last item).
2. A one-page, double-spaced proposal that includes a) project title and description and b) an explanation of how this work will contribute to the university or local/global community, help to develop your professional networks or skills, and is focused on the areas of gender and sexuality.
3. A detailed budget and monetary request. Remember, awards will only be made between \$200–\$500.
